Readme File for IBM TRIRIGA CAD Integrator/Publisher 12.6.0.1 Fix Pack

This fix pack updates the IBM® TRIRIGA® CAD Integrator/Publisher product.

Prerequisites and Supported Products

Prior to installing IBM TRIRIGA CAD Integrator/Publisher, install Microsoft Visual C++ 2010 Redistributable Package (x86) on each workstation.

This version of CAD Integrator may be applied on any 12.1.x or 12.6.0 install as a fix pack (Upgrade Option) or may be installed as a first time install (Install Option).

What's New in This Fix Pack

Installing the IBM TRIRIGA CAD Integrator/Publisher 12.6.0.1 Fix Pack

To install the TRIRIGA CAD Integrator/Publisher 12.6.0.1 fix pack, refer to the following general instructions.

Before You Begin

All drawings that were attached with a prior version must be backed up.

Procedure

1. Download the 12.6.0-TIV-CAD-FP001 file.
2. Extract the file. You can extract the fix pack file into any directory.
3. Double-click the `install_ci_v12.6.0.1.exe` file, and run the installation.

- Follow the prompts provided by the installer to complete the License Agreement and choose options, such as install type, install location, and java locations.



Note - The TRIRIGA CAD Integrator/Publisher JARS and DLLS are updated with the latest version. Third-party libraries are not updated.

What to Do Next

After the install completes, open AutoCAD or MicroStation. In the About dialog box, ensure that the version is now 12.6.0.1.

Batch Process	TRIRIGA CAD Integrator/Publisher Batch Process now displays any errors found during the attachment process for all drawings. The batchProcess.log shows the errors. (Tri-58563-IJ15508)
Space Classes	TRIRIGA CAD Integrator/Publisher validates that the Space Class labels used for spaces can be used in the floorplan. It will now allow duplicate names for the space classes but not for the room names. A space class can be used multiple times. (Tri-59158-IJ16297)
