This fix pack only patches the changes that are described in "IBM TRIRIGA 10.3.2.1 Changes" to your existing platform implementation.

Download the 10.3.2-TIV-PDM-FP001-README readme file and the 10.3.2-TIV-PDM-FP001 package. Follow the directions in the readme file.
