This Interim Fix updates the IBM® OpenPages® GRC Platform environment from version 8.0.0.3.x to 8.0.0.3 IF2 for IBM WebSphere Application Server on AIX or Linux or Windows.

Installation Tasks

To install IBM OpenPages GRC Platform 8.0.0.3 IF2, perform the following tasks.

Task 1: Ensure Global Search has been set up and started

If your deployment has a Global Search server included and you have never started Global Search, you must ensure that you have performed the Search server post installation tasks and that Global Search has been started at least once before applying this interim fix. If your deployment does not have a Global Search server then skip this task.

Note: For details, see the "Search server post installation tasks" topic in the *IBM OpenPages GRC Version 8.0.0 Installation and Deployment Guide* and see the "Starting and stopping servers" chapter in the *IBM*® *OpenPages*® *GRC Administrator's Guide*.

Task 2: Ensure that all OpenPages servers and services are running except the Global Search server

Note: For details, see the "Starting and stopping servers" chapter in the *IBM*® *OpenPages*® *GRC Administrator's Guide.*

Task 3: Apply the OpenPages 8.0.0.3 IF2

Use the 8.0.0.3 OpenPages installer to apply the 8.0.0.3.2 Interim fix. Perform the following steps as the user that setup the Installation Server.

Using the installation app, do the following:

- 3.1 Ensure that the OpenPages 8.0.0.3 installation server is running and that the OpenPages 8.0.0.3 installer agents on the remote servers in the deployment (if applicable) are also running.
- 3.2 Copy the **openpages_interimFix_8-0-0-3-2.zip** file from the interim fix media into the <*InstallerMaintenance>* directory on the installation server.
- 3.3 Open the existing 8.0.0.3.x deployment and press the browser's **Refresh** button to refresh the installation app.
- 3.4 Click the *Deployment Task* drop-down and select *Interim Fix* and select *8.0.0.3.2* in the *Version* drop-down.

Perform the **Validate**, **Install**, and **Configure** actions to apply the interim fix updates to the OpenPages 8.0.0.3.x deployment.

Note: Each file in the OpenPages deployment that is replaced by the interim fix content is automatically backed up into the *<OPBackup8003>*, *<CCBackup8003>* or *<OPSearchBackup8003>* folder, as applicable.

Task 4: Ensure that all OpenPages servers and services are running including the Global Search server

Uninstalling This Patch

Uninstalling 8.0.0.3 IF2 will revert the system to the previous patch level.

To uninstall IBM OpenPages GRC Platform 8.0.0.3 IF2, perform the following tasks as the user that setup the Installation server.

Task 1: Stop all OpenPages servers and services

Note: For details, see the "Starting and stopping servers" chapter in the *IBM*® *OpenPages*® *GRC Administrator's Guide.*

Task 2: Manually restore the previous patch version from the backups

Manually restore the previous OpenPages patch level from the <OPBackup8003> directory created during the 8.0.0.3.2 interim fix installation.

Note: Make sure to use the backup directory that reflects the previously installed OpenPages patch level. Restoring to a patch level that is not the previously installed patch level is not supported.

On each Application Server, do the following:

- 2.1 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/profiles/<OP-node>/installedApps/<OP-Cell>/opapps.ear directory.
- 2.2 Copy the following files from the <OPBackup8003>/profiles/<OPnode>/installedApps/<OP-Cell>/op-apps.ear backup directory:
 - aurora.jar
 - opxss.jar
 - opappsosaupdate.jar
 - opappcommon.jar
 - opfastmap.jar
 - opappsosa.jar
 - com.ibm.openpages.api.rest.jar
- 2.3 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/profiles/<OP-node>/installedApps/<OP-cell>/op-apps.ear/sosa.war/WEB-INF/lib directory.
- 2.4 Copy the following files from the <OPBackup8003>/profiles/<OPnode>/installedApps/<OP-cell>/op-apps.ear/sosa.war/WEB-INF/lib backup directory:
 - opappangular.jar
- 2.5 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/profiles/<OP-node>/installedApps/<OP-cell>/opapps.ear/sosa.war directory and delete the react subdirectory.
- 2.6 Copy the directory and its contents from the <OPBackup8003>/profiles/<OPnode>/installedApps/<OP-cell>/op-apps.ear/sosa.war/react backup directory.
- 2.7 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/profiles/<OP-node>/installedApps/<OP-Cell>/opapps.ear/openpages.war/applets directory.

- 2.8 Copy the following files from the <OPBackup8003>/profiles/<OPnode>/installedApps/<OP-Cell>/op-apps.ear/openpages.war/applets backup directory:

- 2.10 Copy the following files from the <OPBackup8003>/profiles/<OP
 - node>/installedApps/<OP-Cell>/op-apps.ear/openpages.war backup directory:
 unsupportedBrowser.jsp
- 2.11 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/profiles/<OP-node>/installedApps/<OP-Cell>/op-apps.ear/sosa.war directory.
- 2.12 Copy the following files from the <OPBackup8003>/profiles/<OP
 - node>/installedApps/<OP-Cell>/op-apps.ear/sosa.war backup directory:
 - unsupportedBrowser.jsp
- 2.13 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/applications directory.
- 2.14 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8003>/applications backup directory:
 - opappstools.ear
- 2.15 Navigate to the *<OP* Home> directory.
- 2.16 Copy the following file from the <*OPBackup8003*> backup directory:
 - openpagesregistry.xml

On each Reporting Server, do the following:

- 2.1 Navigate to the <*CC_Home*> directory.
- 2.2 Copy the following file from the <CCBackup8003> backup directory:
 - openpagesregistry.xml

On the Global Search Server, do the following:

- 2.1 Navigate to the <OPSearch_Home>/solr/server/solr-webapp/WEB-INF/lib directory.
- 2.2 Delete the file named commons-fileupload-1.2.1.jar.
- 2.3 Rename the file commons-fileupload-1.2.1.jar.backup to commons-fileupload-1.2.1.jar.
- 2.4 Navigate to the <OPSearch_Home> directory.
- 2.5 Copy the following file from the <OPSearchBackup8003> backup directory:
 - openpagesregistry.xml
