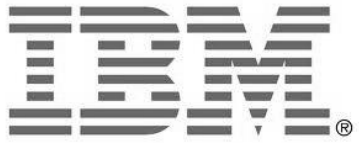

This Interim Fix updates the IBM® OpenPages® with Watson™ environment from version 8.2.0.0 to 8.2.0.0 IF1 on Red Hat Enterprise Linux® (RHEL) or Microsoft™ Windows™

Defect Fixes, Enhancements, and Known Issues

Defect Fixes

The following defect fixes are included in this release. The Authorized Problem Analysis Report (APAR) ID, if available, is shown in parentheses after a description. For example: (PM12345).

OpenPages 8.2.0.0 IF1

- Folder based filters defined in OpenPages 7.2.x are not working after upgrading to 8.1.x (PH25725)
- OpenPages Installer may be putting the wrong Oracle db identifier in bootstrap.properties (PH26948)
- Deleting the temporary file after it is created on a Windows SFTP server fails (PH27187)

Installation Tasks

To install IBM® OpenPages® with Watson™ 8.2.0.0 IF1, perform the following tasks.

Task 1: Stop OpenPages Installation server

Note: For details, see the “Stopping the installation server” topic in “OpenPages installation server and app” chapter in the IBM® OpenPages® GRC Installation and Deployment Guide.

Task 2: Apply Installation Server Updates

Update the Installation server by replacing the current files with the updated files located in the interim fix kit, performing the following steps as the user that setup the Installation server.

- 2.1 Navigate to the directory `<InstallerHome>/src/assets/maintenance` and copy **openpages_installer_8-2-0-0-1.zip** from the kit
- 2.2 Navigate to the `<InstallerHome>` directory and run the command “**npm run upgrade**” from a command or shell window.

Task 3: Start OpenPages Installation server

Task 4: Patching Install Agents

Login to the installation server, select the deployment and click Validate from the deployment

Task 5: Ensure that all OpenPages servers and services are running except the Global Search server

Task 6: Apply the OpenPages 8.2.0.0 IF1

Use the 8.2.0.0.1 OpenPages installer to apply the 8.2.0.0.1 Interim fix. Perform the following steps as the user that setup the Installation Server.

Using the installation app, do the following:

- 6.1 Ensure that the OpenPages 8.2.0.0.1 installation server is running and that the OpenPages 8.2.0.0.1 installer agents on the remote servers in the deployment (if applicable) are also running.
- 6.2 Copy the **openpages_interimFix_8-2-0-0-1.zip** file from the interim fix media into the `<InstallerMaintenance>` directory on the installation server.
- 6.3 Open the existing 8.2.0.0 deployment and press the browser’s **Refresh** button to refresh the installation app.
- 6.4 Click the `Deployment Task` drop-down and select `Interim Fix` and select `8.2.0.0.1` in the *Version* drop-down.

Perform the **Validate**, **Install**, and **Configure** actions to apply the interim fix updates to the OpenPages 8.2.0.0.x deployment.

Note: Each file in the OpenPages deployment that is replaced by the interim fix content is automatically backed up into the <OPBackup8200>, <CCBackup8200>, or <OPSearchBackup8200> folder, as applicable.

Task 7: Ensure that all OpenPages servers and services are running including the Global Search server

Uninstalling this Patch

Uninstalling 8.2.0.0 IF1 will revert the system to the previous patch level.

To uninstall IBM® OpenPages® with Watson™ 8.2.0.0 IF1, perform the following tasks as the user that setup the Installation server.

Task 1: Stop the Install Agents and OpenPages Installation server

To stop the agents, click on the Stop icon on the deployment page for each agent.

Task 2: Restore OpenPages Installation server and Agents

- 2.1 Navigate to the <InstallerHome>/src directory for your installation.
- 2.2 Copy the following file from the <InstallerMaintenance>/archive/backup_<timestamp>/server/src directory to the above directory
 - installer_info.json
- 2.3 Navigate to the <InstallerHome>/src/actions/app-actions directory for your installation.
- 2.4 Copy the following file from the <InstallerMaintenance>/archive/backup_<timestamp>/server/src/actions/app-actions directory to the above directory
 - app_deploy_application_wlp_action.js
- 2.5 Navigate to the <InstallerHome>/src/helpers directory for your installation.
- 2.6 Copy the following files from the <InstallerMaintenance>/archive/backup_<timestamp>/server/src/helpers directory to the above directory
 - db2-helper.js
 - oracle-helper.js
- 2.7 On each machine with an Installer agent, navigate to the <InstallerHome>/src directory for your installation.
- 2.8 Copy the following file from the <InstallerMaintenance>/archive/backup_<timestamp>/agent/src directory to the above directory
 - installer_info.json
- 2.9 Navigate to the <InstallerHome>/src/actions/app-actions directory for your installation.

- 2.10 Copy the following file from the <InstallerMaintenance>/archive/backup_<timestamp>/agent/src/actions/app-actions directory to the above directory
- app_deploy_application_wlp_action.js
- 2.11 Navigate to the <InstallerHome>/src/helpers directory for your installation.
- 2.12 Copy the following files from the <InstallerMaintenance>/archive/backup_<timestamp>/agent/src/actions/app-actions directory to the above directory
- db2-helper.js
 - oracle-helper.js

Task 3: Start OpenPages Installation server

Task 4: Start the Install Agents

Login to the installation server, select the deployment and click Validate from the deployment.

Task 5: Stop all OpenPages servers and services

Task 6: Manually restore the previous patch version from the backups

Manually restore the previous OpenPages patch level from the <OPBackup8200>, <CCBackup8200>, or <OPSearchBackup8200> directories created during the 8.2.0.0.1 interim fix installation, as applicable.

Note: Make sure to use the backup directory that reflects the previously installed OpenPages patch level. Restoring to a patch level that is not the previously installed patch level is not supported.

Application Servers

On each Application Server, do the following

- 6.1 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/applications directory.
- 6.2 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8200>/applications directory:
 - op-apps.ear
- 6.3 Navigate to the <OP_APP_Home> directory.
- 6.4 Copy the following files from the <OPBackup8200>/wlp-usr/shared/apps/op-apps.ear directory:
 - aurora.jar
 - opappsosaupdate.jar
 - com.ibm.openpages.integration.feedimport.jar
- 6.5 Navigate to the <OP_APP_Home>/openpages.war/applets directory.
- 6.6 Copy the following files from the <OPBackup8200>/wlp-usr/shared/apps/op-apps.ear/openpages.war/applets directory:
 - aurora.jar

- opsdk.jar

6.7 Navigate to the <OP_Home>/aurora/conf directory.

6.8 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8200>/aurora/conf directory:

- versioninfo.txt

6.9 Navigate to the <OP_Home> directory.

6.10 Copy the following file from the <OPBackup8200> directory:

- openpagesregistry.xml

6.11 Navigate to the <CC_Home> directory.

6.12 Copy the following file from the <CCBackup8200> directory:

- openpagesregistry.xml

Global Search Server

On the Global Search Server, do the following

6.13 Navigate to the <OPSearch_Home> directory.

6.14 Copy the following file from the <OPSearchBackup8200> directory:

- openpagesregistry.xml
