CORRECTED ISSUES

RES-5602	If there are multiple users with same first and last name, the wrong email address is used when mentioning the other user in the Notes field.
RES-8453	Double-byte characters do not display properly within an email notification.
RES-8645	When using Internet Explorer as a browser to generate an incident printable report, the timeline and statics graphic data is missing.
RES-9323	@Mentions does not work if a user's name contains certain special characters.
RES-9328	When editing a note, text that is underlined is changed to strike-through.
RES-9345	The first letter input via Japanese Windows IME in the Text Area field is ignored.
RES-0007	The Rules page does not display correctly if a user deletes an activity field used by a rule.
