Leveraging a bi-directional integration between IBM's QRadar and the Resilient Incident Response Platform, the Resilient QRadar Integration App streamlines the process of escalating and managing the security incidents that originate in QRadar.

FEATURES AND ENHANCEMENTS

The V3.1.2 release introduces support for the V29 release of the Resilient Incident Response Platform, both RHEL and Debian versions, as well as support for the Resilient platform roles and permissions feature.

This release also includes bug fixes. All changes and bug fixes from the previous V3.1.1 release are included.

CORRECTED ISSUES

Tracking Code	Issue
DE3511	Some saved offenses are not escalated in the database.
DE3503	Offenses with double quotes in the name fail to be escalated.
DE3499	Not all offenses are selected to be checked against escalation rules.
DE3491	Error after changing user permissions.
DE3489	Verification of permissions should occur when saving integration configuration.
DE3477	Incorrect error message when clicking "Send to Resilient" when the integration is not configured.
DE3398	Task notes do not sync from the Resilient platform to QRadar.
DE2598	Closing an offense that contains required fields that are empty should display an error message.
DE2438	Purged offenses result in many 404 errors if the incident still active.
