- An IDA Atomic Warehouse Data Model, containing System of Record entities
- An IDA Dimensional Warehouse Data Model, including Transactional, Aggregate and Dimensional entities

Note: ERwin equivalents of the above models are also included

- An InfoSphere Business Glossary (BG) representation of Business Terms, Analytical Requirements

Note: The IDA logical models are mapped to the Business Glossary content.

## Known issues and limitations

Reference	Description
12352	Some customization of Aggregate Fact tables may be required if the granularity is too detailed.  Work-around: If a dimension is too granular for a particular fact table, delete the relationship between the fact table and dimension e.g. remove relationship to Customer Dimension but keep relationship to Customer Mini Dimension.
12351	Dimensional Warehouse Model: Nine measures in fact entities have non numeric domain.  Work-around: Change attribute domain Data Type to numeric.
12299	In the Atomic Warehouse Model, three customer loyalty scheme entities are in the incorrect packages i.e.: 1. <i>Loyalty Scheme Product</i> is in <i>Product &gt; Product Fundamentals</i> package 2. <i>Loyalty Scheme Arrangement</i> is in <i>Event &gt; Event Fundamentals</i> package 3. <i>Loyalty Scheme AR / Transaction Rltnp</i> is in <i>Event &gt; Event Fundamentals</i> package  Work-around: Move entities to appropriate packages. Move: 1. <i>Loyalty Scheme Product</i> to <i>Product</i> package 2. <i>Loyalty Scheme Arrangement</i> to <i>Arrangement</i> package 3. <i>Loyalty Scheme AR / Transaction Rltnp</i> to <i>Associatives</i> package
12368	Additional scope related to mini-dimension listed in Scopes package in InfoSphere
